## Nursery Extension Update

Parents and carers may have noticed that our Nursery outdoor area has recently been cleared. This marks the beginning of an exciting development project to enhance our provision for our youngest pupils.

From next week, work will begin on the foundations for the new extension. During this initial phase, there will be a temporary change to Nursery routines. Nursery children should be dropped off at the **main school entrance** and collected from the **Reception ramp (halfway down the playground)**. Staff will be on hand to support and ensure a smooth transition.

The main phase of construction will begin approximately three weeks before the summer holidays. We will continue to keep you updated as the project progresses and will aim to minimise disruption wherever possible.

We are delighted that the new Nursery extension is scheduled to open in **September**, providing an improved learning environment and enhanced outdoor and indoor facilities for our children.
